






Charlie began his career as a photographer in advertising when he joined his father's company, Mainardi Photographers, which is a studio that specializes in car photography. He since worked for almost every car company worldwide, including Peugeot, Hyundai, Ford, GMC, and Volkswagen, shooting in Europe, the United States, Argentina, and Africa.

Charlie went on to represent the worldwide campaign for Absolut Vodka. He also worked on the campaign for the Renault global Coca-Cola campaign. He won several awards for his photography and directorial work at local and regional festivals in Argentina, as well as Cannes, and New York.

In 2013, through the Saatchi Art Gallery, Charlie sold his "Maciel" series, which was a collection of his work developed over a year in a slum, which went on to be recognized by the Secretary of Culture of Argentina.

Recently, the David Nalbandian Foundation commissioned Charlie to photograph the problem of infant mortality to raise awareness. He also produced two feature films and directed

Pictures produced by Paradox Studios are fully financed by the partners. As part of The Ambi Group, Paradox Studios has access to AMBI's resources in addition to its own, including the recently announced \$200 Million Dollar fund launched by Ambi Group and Raven Capital Management. As part of the AMBI Group, Paradox Studios films are marketed and sold internationally by AMBI Distribution, headed by veteran sales agents Julie Sultan and Elisabeth Costa de Beauregard.

In 2013, the Paradox film Ain't Them Bodies Saints, starring Rooney Mara and Casey Affleck, debuted at Sundance to critical acclaim. In the same year, the thrillers financed and produced by Paradox Studios, Reasonable Doubt starring Samuel L. Jackson and Dominic Cooper and Reclaim starring John Cusack were both picked up and released by Lionsgate in the US. In 2014, Paradox financed and produced the romantic comedy All Roads Lead to Rome starring Sarah Jessica Parker, Raoul Bova and Claudia Cardinale. The film, shot on location throughout the scenic countryside of Tuscany and the city of Rome has been sold in every territory of the world, and will be released by Eone in the US. In 2015, Paradox Studios produced the psychological thriller Lavender starring Abbie Cornish, Dermot Mulroney, and Justin Long, which is now in post production, Netflix bought worldwide SVOD rights.
